| **Article VI: DISSOLUTION OF THE ASSOCIATION**

The Association may dissolve by a vote of majority of its members in a general or special meeting. In the event of dissolution, the majority of the Board of Directors shall determine distribution of Association capital and property.

| **Article VII: AMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS**

The By-Laws may be amended at any general meeting by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members present, provided that the substance and effect of any proposed amendment shall have been published in the newsletter to inform all members of the proposed changes.

CONSTITUTION**

Article I: NAME

The organization shall be known as the Minnesota Companion Bird Association.

Article II: PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business of this Association shall be located in the State of Minnesota.
There shall be no provision for any chapters.

Article III: PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE
